Sec. 3-1. Number of election officials.

- (a) The town clerk shall have discretion to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from 7 to 5 or not less than 3.
- (b) In addition to Sec 3-1(a), the town clerk shall have discretion to utilize one additional inspector to serve at each polling place without regard to party affiliation who shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and who shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.

Sec. 3-2. Split-shifts for election officials.

(a) The town clerk shall have discretion for the selection of alternate officials or the selection of 2 or more sets of officials to work at different times on election day, and may establish different working hours for different officials assigned to the same polling place.
